

The Aspetuck Health District has received phone calls from Westport residents concerning a letter recently received from the Aquarion Water Company. The Aquarion letter stated that “*Our most recent service line inventory indicates that some or all of the water service line materials between the water main and your property are of **unknown material classification**. Unknown means that the service line may be lead.*”

**The Aquarion letter has raised concerns with residents looking to have their water tested. The Health District is not a laboratory and can not test water for the presence of lead.
